*News & Updates*

- We will be maintaining our current screening processes through spring break. After Spring Break (04/12), we will have a modified process with mask checks and screening students for exposure, symptoms or diagnosis. Students should still wait in their cars with parents until screening starts.
- This week, we will be fully remote and asynchronous for Wednesday (03/31) and Thursday (04/01). We will host homeroom daily and take attendance. On Wednesday, March 31, students will complete SCA #7.
- Students should work to ensure that all work is completed in Google Classroom by Friday, April 9. After that date, students will be assigned a grade of 50.
- Device return is not required at this time. However, if your student is returning to school 5 days a week, you can optionally return your students laptop/hot spot if you no longer want the responsibility of a school device. Fees for loss (\$700) will need to be finalized by the end of the year.
- The Scholastic Virtual Book Fair will be April 5th-18th to coincide with National Library Week.
