*News & Updates*

- We will go over Plan A Updates in homeroom on April 12. You can preview the lesson [here](#) to prepare.
- We will be maintaining student screening after spring break with a modified process. We will conduct mask checks before exiting cars and screen students for exposure, symptoms or diagnosis. Students should wait in their cars with parents until screening starts.
- Students should work to ensure that all work is completed in Google Classroom by Friday, April 9. After that date, students will be assigned a grade of 50. Students who failed a core course quarter 3 should have received an email about grade recovery.
- Celebrate Plan A with a spirit week (April 12-16). NHCS dress code (03/02/21) will be enforced.
- Device return is not required at this time. However, if your student is returning to school 5 days a week, you can optionally return your student's laptop/hotspot if you no longer want the responsibility of a school device. Fees for loss (\$700) will need to be finalized by the end of the year.
- The Scholastic Virtual Book Fair will be April 5th-18th to coincide with National Library Week.
